Treasurer's Report:

• Financials for FY23 and March 2023 were distributed. Any discussion or questions?

Executive Director's Report:

- Beyond what has been discussed and distributed, do any of you have any questions or clarification about what I will be working on, or specific requests about anything I should be working on? Here are a couple other things, beyond what's in my work plan (still under Treasurer in the strategic plan) that I want to work on as time allows:
 - Work with Melissa (and others) to bring the new website up to date.
 - "Clean up" google drive (with help of others). There is a lot of old, useless stuff that's been posted over the years, and it's not very well organized.
- The "employment agreement" has been updated to reflect the correct dates, and has been signed by me and by Rick.

Old Business (President):

• Still need to follow up with some BOD members about annual plans. Jonathan will follow up. Rick back in the office Tuesday next week.

New Business (President):

- Bill Wade resigned from the position of treasurer, effective April 20, 2023, and was appointed as executive director on the same date by the required ²/₃ vote of the Board of Directors.
 - Proposal: Meg to fill the remainder of Bill's term (ends Dec 2023). They'll recruit a new person starting next year. Bill will continue to work with Melissa on financials, but Meg will provide additional oversight.
 - Vote: Rick makes motion. Mike seconds. Approved by ayes.
 - Nominations for position will come forward in November (along with three other positions).
- (Wade): Discussion about RR47 (2024) venue. As of this time, the leading candidates are Corpus Christi, Rapid City and Tucson (though there may be sentiment for not returning to Tucson so soon after RR45). I am in the process of getting several questions answered from each of the candidates.
 - Would a change to Saturday through Saturday, rather than Sunday through Sunday work better?
 - Meeting discussion:
 - Referring to spreadsheet in meeting. Dates Nov 3-11.
 - Following up with Corpus Christi and Rapid City. Not currently following up with Tucson. Could return to Westward Look in Tucson in 2026.
 - Holiday Inn in Rapid City is better deal for attendees (more taxes and higher room rate in CC). Corpus Christi location would likely benefit the organization more with comps etc. Benefiting the attendees benefits the organization.
 - What about flights into both areas? Probably comparable. Allegiant, Delta, or United likely through Denver. People more concerned about hotel room rate than flights.
 - Corpus Christi has nicer weather in November. Many use this trip as vacation. It is a long time since we've been (1999). The hotel in CC looks nicer.
 - Hotel in good location in Rapid City. About 3-4 blocks to restaurants etc. Would be in good fall colors in the Dakotas at that time.
 - Better access to NPS sites outside of Rapid City. Minuteman, Badlands, Mt Rushmore, Wind Cave. Just Pedro Island and maybe LBJ from Corpus Christi.
 - Both Mike and Rick have contacts and can help coordinate at Rapid City.
 - At Corpus Christi perhaps we offer to raise rates on food and beverage to lower the nightly parking rate near the hotel.
 - Bill worked through the Convention Visitors Bureau in each location. Both comparable.
 - Action: All BOD members send Bill an email stating your preference by end of day Thursday. Bill will follow up with email to BOD with recommendation.
 - Pros to Rapid City from Mike: Holiday Inn a fine facility. Eastern slope of Black Hills is the banana belt. Usually mild that time of year. 17 units within a

half day drive. Plus great state parks. With 6-8 parks in short drive, we could attract a larger park service audience.

- We'd need to find someone local to help with setting up a conference in Corpus Christi.
- RE: Sun-Sun or Sat to Sat:
 - BOD agrees this would be good to try. Bill to follow up with hotels to see if it is doable.

 - Tom requested the addition of a Training link to our members page to allow access to future and past trainings. This will start with Bill Pierce's training.

- I'm continuing to work with the RR committee to flesh out details for this year's Ranger Rendezvous. We met once in the last month to review the status.
- I missed the membership committee meeting due to travel but continue to stay active in that as needed. I'm worked on cross-referencing past/lapsed members with current members to capture any missing members. This resulted in reviving about a dozen Lifetime members who were listed as inactive but did not wish to be so.
- Education and Training:
